

ADVANCED PLACEMENT CLASSES

Every student deserves to be challenged academically. To that end, all high school students in the Douglas County School District shall have access to Advanced Placement classes at their home high school. With very limited exceptions, every comprehensive high school shall offer, at a minimum, at least one Advanced Placement class in each of the four core academic subjects (English, mathematics, science, and social studies). High schools are encouraged to offer a wide range of Advanced Placement courses in all content areas.

Students enrolled in Advanced Placement classes are required to take the Advanced Placement examination at the end of the year. Students will be encouraged to challenge themselves by enrolling in Advanced Placement classes. If students require financial help to pay for the Advanced Placement exam, confidential assistance will be available.

Annual reports on enrollment and performance of students in Advanced Placement classes shall be provided to the Board of Trustees.
