Under the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA), a student with a disability, who is placed by his/her parents in a home school program, has no individual entitlement to receive the special education and related services they would receive if enrolled in a public school. However, a proportionate amount of federal funding for services for home schooled students is available. The amount of federal funding available is based upon the number of home schooled students who have been found eligible for services in accordance with state and federal requirements.

If you feel your child has a disability or a learning problem, Douglas County School District (DCSD) has "Child Find" responsibilities to locate, identify, and evaluate individuals three through 21 years of age, who are suspected of having a disability and being in need of special education. If you suspect that your child has a disability and would like to have your child evaluated, please contact the Special Services office at (775) 265-5262. If your child has already been determined eligible in accordance with the state's requirements and you would like more information about services, please contact the Special Services office at the number listed above. For your convenience, we have created the bottom section of this form for you to reflect this information. If you choose to complete this optional section, someone from our office will contact you.

If you, as the parent, elect to enroll your child in DCSD, the district will, with your permission, determine your child's eligibility for special education services and develop an Individual Education Plan (IEP) in accordance with state and federal requirements.
