Service Animals

The Douglas County School District is committed to providing equal access to its programs, activities, events and facilities and will not discriminate against any individual regardless of his or her disability. Individuals who, because of the nature of their disability, require assistance of a "service animal," to access Douglas County School District programs, activities, events and facilities shall not be denied access subject to Administrative Regulation No. 207A.

The Board of Trustees prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability. Individuals with disabilities have the same right as individuals without disabilities to the use and enjoyment of our schools. As a result, the Board of Trustees recognizes its duty to make reasonable accommodations for an individual with a disability for use of a service animal on school property.
