Summer school is a district-wide remediation and intervention opportunity for Douglas County School District students in grades 7-12. Courses are developed based on student need and highly qualified teacher availability.

Space is limited! Students will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

English, History, Science, Social Studies, and Math Credit Recovery (7th – 12th grade)	Credit Awarded	Tuition
The goal is to recover credit where the student is deficient towards graduation (or promotion) requirements. Students will utilize A+ Software to complete the objectives needed to earn credit. Financial Assistance:

Financial assistance is available upon request. You will have an opportunity to request a reduction in course fees when completing the registration form. Please note that the minimum fee to attend summer school is \$15.00.

Attendance Policy:

If a student is absent more than two (2) days, they will be withdrawn from summer school for the remainder of the program and no credit and/or competency recovery will be granted. Tardies will be counted as absences for any student who misses more than ten (10) minutes of any class on any given day. Tuition will not be refunded for students withdrawn due to attendance issues.

Discipline Policy:

A student who has been referred to the office twice by an adult, or who has violated Board Policy No. 529, "SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION," will be un-enrolled from summer school for the remainder of the program. No credit and/or competency recovery will be granted, and the student may face suspension or expulsion for the next school year. Tuition will not be refunded for students withdrawn due to disciplinary action.
